HERITAGE CASEMENT WINDOW

Lignum timber Heritage casement windows offer a traditional design that suits any property style. A popular choice for replacing conservation windows, the flush sash frame can also be paired with putty glazing bars and profile glazing bars to give a softer elegant feel to the window.

Externally, the outer frame and sash are flush and feature slim sightlines to provide a larger glass area. The window system is internally beaded to enhance security. The putty bevel externally gives a traditional look in keeping for conservation areas.

The Lignum Heritage Casement Window has a slim 16mm glazing unit to fit into traditional timber rebates. The 16mm unit can use Krypton gas in the cavity to improve thermal performance to a value of 1.1Wm2K meeting current Document L regulations.

Trickle Vent	Can be fitted through head (Head Drip)



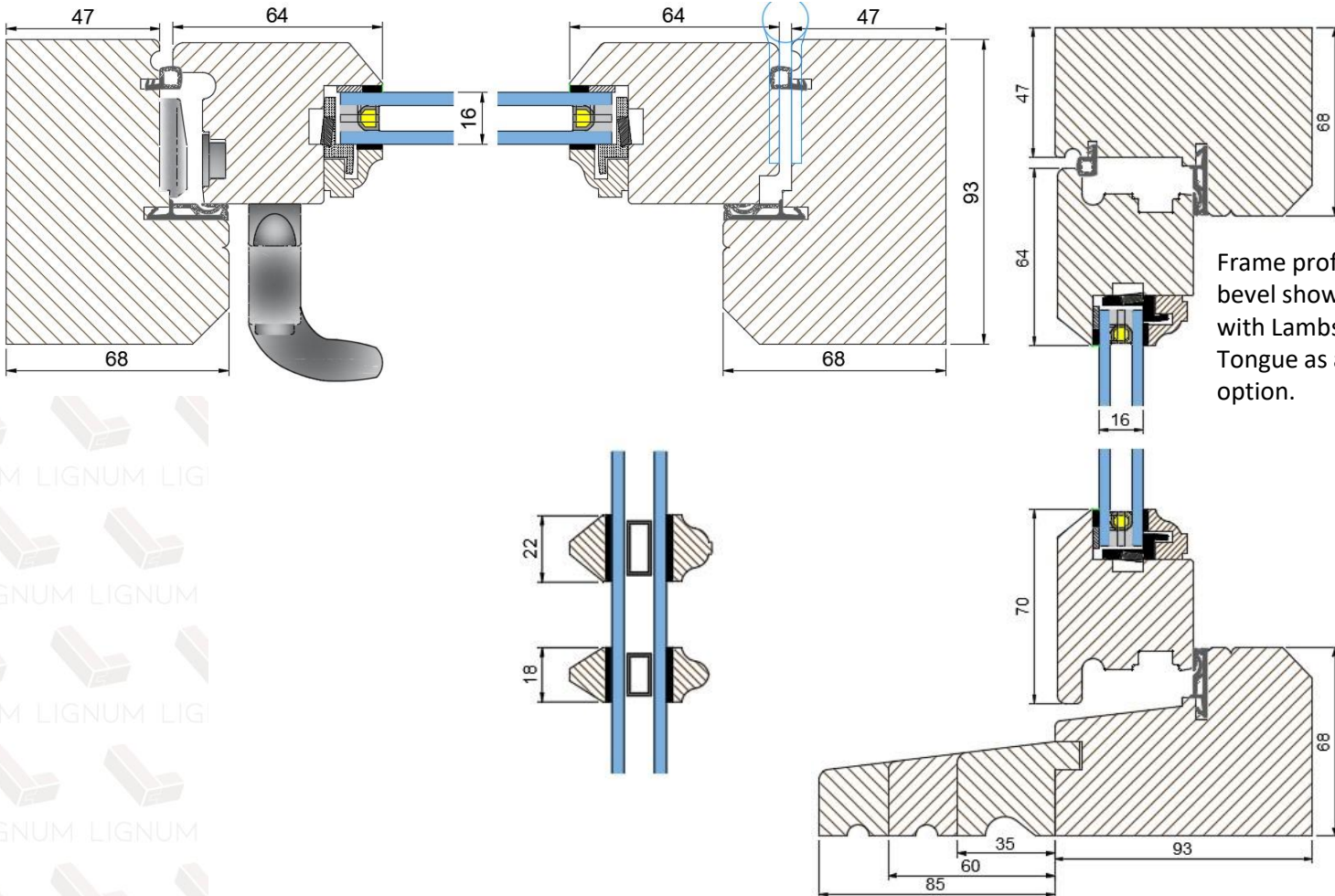
